Paying By Credit Card?

Once you click **Submit**, you will be redirected to the Secure PayPal website. If you have a PayPal account with the credit card you plan to use, you must log into your PayPal account. If you do not have a PayPal account nor want to create one, click **Don't Have a PayPal account** on the right and follow the instructions.

Be sure to complete all the steps and then click **Return to Seniors College site** to register for your courses.

- **E-Transfer/Cheques must be sent to the above addresses within 10 days or your account will be cancelled.**
- **Paying by e-Transfer/Cheque:** Important to select e-Transfer/Cheque payment method to set your account to 'Paid -payment pending' and permit you to register before payment is received by Seniors College.
- **Include your member name** on e-Transfer/cheque information line.
- **Paying by credit card:** Use your PayPal account if you have one, create a Paypal account or use your credit card without a Paypal account. If the credit card you plan to use is already attached to a Paypal account, you must sign into your account.

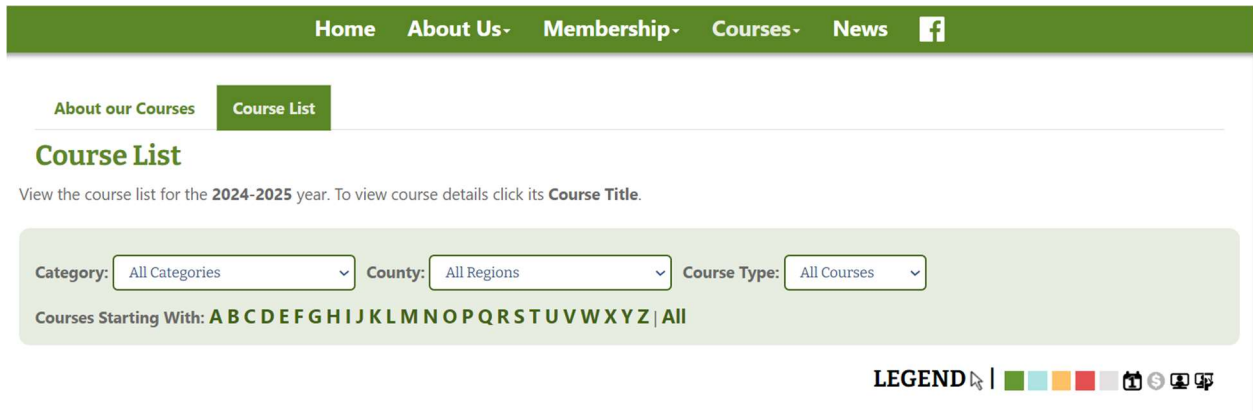

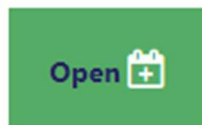
